**OPERATIONAL ISSUES FORCE EMERGENCY SHUTDOWN OF
WATER SUPPLY FACILITIES IN ST. CATHERINE
SECTIONS OF PORTMORE AND ST. ANDREW IMPACTED**

The **National Water Commission** is advising that a mechanical problem has forced the shut down of operations at the Well G water supply system in St. Catherine. The company is also noting that Well F has been extracted for urgent maintenance work. As a result, the following communities will experience low or no water conditions until these works are completed.
