BROKEN MAIN CAUSES WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION IN CLARENDON AREAS
MINERAL HEIGHTS AND SURROUNDINGS AFFECTED

The National Water Commission is advising its customers that a damaged section of transmission pipeline has forced the shutdown of the Mineral Heights water supply facility in Clarendon. The Company is advising that customers served by the facility will experience a disruption in their regular water (low pressures or no water conditions) until the necessary repairs are completed.

Completion timeline: **6pm, today, Wednesday- October 13, 2021**

Affected to be impacted: **Mineral Heights, Halse Hall, sections of May Pen, Curatoe Hill, Canaan Heights, Trenton Road, Longbridge Avenue and Sunnyside Avenue**

The NWC apologises to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure them that every effort will be made to restore regular water supply in the shortest possible time.
