HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACT WATER SUPPLY IN KELLITS AREAS KELLITS, CROFT'S HILL AND SURROUNDING AREAS AFFECTED

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the shutdown of operations at the Kellits water supply system in Clarendon. This will result in a water supply disruption to communities supplied by the facilities.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas affected: **Kellits, Croft's Hill, Good Hope, Tate, Pedro, Rhoden Hall, Guava Ground, Hickery, Comsie, Jericho and environs**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
