NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY IN ST CATHERINE AREAS

The National Water Commission is advising that operations have now restarted at the Bybrook #3 system situated in St. Catherine following the resolution of operational issues at the plant. Based on this progress, the NWC seeks the continued patience of affected customers as the network recharges over the next several hours.

Areas being restored: Princessfield, August Town, Cow Gully, High Mountain, West Prospect, Cashew Walk, Hyde Lane, sections of Church Road, Burton, Wonder Lane and Azar lane

In addition, restoration work is nearing its completion at the Jericho and Nutshell systems that supply water to Ewarton, sections of Linstead and surrounding areas.

Estimated Restoration Time: **6pm today, October 13, 2021**

Areas to be affected: Cotton Piece, Charlemont H/S, White House H/S, Orangefield Village, Ewarton, Mt. Rosser, Ivy District, Bennett Shop, Waterloo, Leslie Rd, Cassava Pond, Charlton H/S, Polly Ground, Charlton Drive, Henry Lane, Tucker Road and Lane, Cogheil Road.

Other areas include: Jericho and Sections of Linstead, York Street Booster Station, Banbury, Victoria,
