MAINTENANCE WORKS NOW UNDERWAY AT EAST KINGSTON FACILITIES

WATER SUPPLY OPERATIONS TO BE IMPACTED FOR SEVERAL HOURS

The **National Water Commission** wishes to advise its customers that scheduled well testing activities are now being carried out at the Long Mountain facility that is now shut down for overall rehabilitation works. Based on this work, it will also be necessary to temporarily suspend operations at the Rennock Lodge system that now provides regulated supply to the east Kingston areas.

Disruption period starts: **10pm on Tuesday October 12, 2021**

Restoration Time: **on or before 4pm on Wednesday, October 13, 2021**

The company is noting that while the systems are out of operations, customers may experience low pressures or disruptions within the supply windows that are now in effect. The NWC is therefore advising persons to store water for use during this period of possible disruption or low pressures.

Affected areas include: **Windward Road and roads leading off, Rollington Town, sections of Deanery Road, Langston Road, Harbour View, Palisadoes Strip and Port Royal, Shooter's Hill, Seven Miles to eleven Miles and environs**

Customers are reminded that the existing water supply schedule will resume once the tests are completed. Persons may expect a gradual increase in pressures after the restart of operations, due to the gradual recharging of the network.

The **National Water Commission** apologises for any inconvenience that may be caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply on or before the times specified.
