BROKEN MAIN DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers that operations at its Parklee facility in St. Elizabeth have been temporarily shut down due to a broken transmission main on the network. As result, customers served by the facility are currently experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

Affected areas include Malvern, Munro, Hampton, Bethlehem, Belleview H/S, Top Hill, Southfield, Seaview, Congo Hole, Yardley Chase, St. Mary's, Portsea, Milksham, Red Bank, Round Hill, Corby, Barber Green.

Repairs will be completed by tomorrow Thursday, October 14, 2021.
