## **HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACT WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM IN PORTLAND**

**MOUNT PLEASANT, INDUSTRY, CONTENT BAY AND SECTIONS OF WYDAH AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the suspension of operations at the Mount Pleasant water supply system located in Portland. These issues will result in water supply disruptions to communities supplied by the facility.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Area affected: **Mount Pleasant, Industry, Panton, Content Bay Road, Darley, sections of Wydah**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
