**JPSco SINGLE PHASE ISSUE DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY OPERATIONS IN
ST. CATHERINE**

FREE TOWN, BRENARD, SUE RIVER, GLENGOFFE AND ENVIRONS IMPACTED

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that a JPSco single phase issue has forced the suspension of operations at the Sue River Water Supply system in St. Catherine. The Company is noting that this issue has resulted in water supply disruptions to the communities served by the system.

Areas to be impacted: **Free Town, Brenard, Sue River, Mizpah, St. Faiths, Cassava River, Glengoffe, Goffe Road, Jambos Pond, Big Road**

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply operations will be restarted as soon as the power supply problems are corrected.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
