The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that a JPSco power supply outage has forced the shutdown of operations at the Tulloch Spring facility in St. Catherine and has resulted in water supply disruptions to a number of communities served.

Areas Affected: **Kent Village, Sections of Spanish Town, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gdns & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Braeton B/S, Eltham Acres, Eltham, Greendale, Keystone, St Jago**

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply will be restored as soon as the power supply problem is corrected.
