**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS CONTINUE TO AFFECT WAKEFIELD AREAS  
WAKEFIELD, BANBURY AND SURROUNDING AREAS AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that persistent high turbidity levels have forced the extended shutdown of operations at the Wakefield water supply system in St. Catherine. This outage has resulted in a water supply disruption to communities supplied by the facility.

Customers are being assured that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution. Based on progress thus far- the NWC estimates that restoration can commence by **this 5pm afternoon, October 20, 2021.**

Areas affected:       **Wakefield Main Road, Buxton Town, Savannah, Banbury and Environs**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
