**ELECTRO-MECHANICAL ISSUES IMPACT WATER SUPPLY
AREAS IN ST CATHERINE AND ST ANDREW AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that electro-mechanical issue has now disrupted operations at the NWC water supply wells E, F and W that are situated in St Catherine. While the Company has taken active steps to minimize the impact on customer supply, there is a possibility that some areas will experience low water pressures or no water conditions between Saturday, October 23, 2021 and Sunday, October 24, 2021.

St Catherine Areas: Kent Village, Sections of Spanish Town, Spanish Town Road, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Eltham Acres, Eltham, Greendale, Keystone, St Jago, Hellshire areas

KSA Areas: Cooreville Gardens, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Molyne Road, Spanish Town Road and Roads leading off, Sections of Downtown Kingston

The Public is also being notified that trucking has commenced for some areas in Kingston that have been affected for some days.

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply will be restored as soon as the issues are resolved. A further update will be provided on Monday, October 24th 2021.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
