**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACT WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS IN CLARENDON
PEACE RIVER, THOMPSON TOWN AND ENVIRONS AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the shutdown of operations at the Peace River water supply system in Clarendon. This will result in a water supply disruption to communities supplied by the facility.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas Affected: **Peace River, Gloucester, Victoria, Lodge, Thompson Town, Cove,
Wesleyan Gully, Blackwood, Elgin**
