**JPSCo POWER SUPPLY PROBLEMS DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY  
APPLE FARM AND NEW PERA WATER FACILITIES IN ST. THOMAS AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that JPSCo power supply problems have forced the shutdown of operations at the **Apple Farm** and **New Pera Water Facilities** in **St. Thomas**. This has resulted in water supply disruption to customers served by the facilities.

Areas impacted: **Aelous Valley, Scotlang Gate, Amity Hall Wheelersfield, Springfield, Barking Lodge, New Pera, Hill Top, Chapel Hill, Cracket Hill, Ginger Piece, Pear Tree River, Bachelor's Hall, Apple Farm, Dalvey, Duckenfield, Hampton Court, Cheswick, Brown, Pera, New Pera, Bowden, sections of Barking Lodge and Phillipsfield**

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply will be restored as soon as the power supply problems are corrected.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
