## **SCHEDULED PIPELINE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY** SPANISH TOWN ROAD AND ENVIRONS TO BE AFFECTED

The National Water Commission is advising that water distribution on the Spanish Town Road network in St Andrew will be suspended on Thursday, November 25, 2021 in order to facilitate pipeline works related to the completion of the first phase of the major pipeline works along Spanish Town Road.

During these activities, customers are being urged that where possible to store water for use as the period of disruption in each instance will be for approximately 24 hours.

Disruption Time: **8:00am to 10:00pm on Thursday, November 25, 2021**

Areas to be affected: **Marcus Garvey Drive, Spanish Town Road and all roads leading off, sections of Washington Gardens, Cooreville Gardens and New Haven**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
