**JPSCO POWER SUPPLY ISSUE DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that high voltage issues have forced the shutdown of operations at the Colbeck and Rhoden Pen water supply facilities in St Catherine and these have resulted in water supply disruptions to a number of communities served.

Areas Affected: **Sections of Colbeck, Aviary H/S, New Harbour Village H/S Phases 1, 2, 3 & 4 Old Harbour Bay, Presidential Estate, Planters and Bois Content,**

The National Water Commission seeks to assure the public that regular water supply will be restored as soon as the power supply problem is corrected.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
