**EMERGENCY VALVE REPLACEMENT WORKS DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY
WOODHALL ENNIS TURNERS AND ENVIRONS IN CLARENDON AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission is advising that operations at the **Low Ground Wells** in **Clarendon** have been suspended to facilitate emergency valve replacement works along the pipeline network. This has resulted in water supply disruption to the communities served by the facilities.

The works are estimated to be completed by **1:00 pm today, November 25, 2021.**

Areas impacted: **Woodhall, Ennis, Suttons, Teak Pen, Turners, Four Paths Post Road, Chapelton, New Longsville, New Roads, Sangsters Heights, New Danks, Shingle Hut, Mt Province, Sine, Alexandria, Married Lane**
