VALVE INSTALLATION WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY
JERICO, EWARTON AND ENVIRONS TO BE IMPACTED

The National Water Commission is advising that its teams will be carrying out installation work at the Jericho water treatment facility in St Catherine on Friday, November 26, 2021. This work will force a shutdown of operations at the Jericho and Nutshell plants. Based on this activity, piped supply to customer will be disrupted for the duration of the work.

Work period: 10am to 6pm on Friday, November 26, 2021

Affected areas include: White House H/S, Banbury, Victoria, Orangefield, Jericho and Sections of Linstead, York Street, Cotton Piece, Charliemount H/S, White House H/S, Orangefield Village, Ewarton, Mt. Rosser, Ivy District, Bennett Shop, Waterloo, Leslie Rd, Cassava Pond, Charlton H/S, Polly Ground, Charlton Drive, Heny Lane, Tucker Road and Lane, Cogheil Road.

The Company urges residents in the stated areas to store water ahead of this disruption.

The NWC is assuring the public that every effort will be made to restore their regular supply ahead of the stipulated timeline.
