OPERATIONAL ISSUE DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY OPERATIONS AT WHITE MARL FACILITY

SECTIONS OF WASHINGTON BOULEVARD AND MOLYNES AREAS TO BE ST. AFFECTED

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that an operational issue has forced a suspension of operations at the **White Marl #1, 2 and 3** pumps. This shutdown will result in a disruption to regular water supply (low pressures or no water conditions) to the St Andrew communities that are served by the plant.

The Company is noting that the relevant teams are now working to resolve the issue within the shortest possible time.

Restoration Time: **9pm, today, Thursday, November 25, 2021**

Affected areas include: **Washington Boulevard and roads including sections of Duhaney Park, and Patrick City, Sections of Washington Gardens, Hughenden, Molyne's Road, Moreton Park Seaward Drive, Olympic Way, Penwood, Waterhouse and surrounding areas**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience that these disruptions in service may cause.
