The National Water Commission is advising that operation at the **Barnett Wood Water Facility** in **St. Andrew** is presently suspended as a result of mechanical issues developed with the pumping unit.

Following an assessment, the company is indicating that a further update will be provided regarding the timeline for the restart of the facility.

Areas impacted: **Coopers Hill, Castle James, Padmore, Swain Spring, Maverly Mountain, Burnt Side, Burnt Side Valley and Top section of Sterling Castle**
