## **WELL REHABILITATION WORK TO IMPACT PALMETTO PEN WATER FACILITY IN CLARENDON**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the **Palmetto Pen Water Facility** in **Clarendon** will be suspended from **Monday, January 24, 2022** to **Monday, February 14, 2022** to facilitate well rehabilitation activities at the facility. This work is necessary to safeguard the viability of the well and to improve overall efficiency of water supply operations.

Customers served by this system are being encouraged to store water for use during the disruption period. In the interim water will be trucked to the affected areas.

Areas to be affected include: **Palmetto Pen, Rosewell, Sandy Bay, Gren Park, Free Town, Green Bottom, Breadnut Bottom, Kennedy Run, Palmers Cross, Chatteau, Rosewell Road, Cock Pit, Bodles, Sunrise Drive, Rose Haal, Toby Heights, Hartwell Gardens, Rhules Pen, Merrivale Meadows**
