**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACTING WATER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION
DRUMMOND SPRING, PEACE RIVER AND ENVIRONS IN CLARENDON AFFECTED**

The **National Water Commission** is reporting that high turbidity levels are currently impacting operations at the **Drummond Spring** and **Peace River Water Facilities** in **Clarendon**. This has caused a disruption in regular water supply to customers served by the facilities.

Customers are being advised that once conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas impacted: **Drummond Spring, Beckford, Kraal, Iron Gate, Trumpit Tree, Peace River, Gloucester, Victoria, Lodge, Thompson Town, Cove, Wesleyan Gully, Blackwood and Elgin**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
