JPSCO LOW VOLTAGE IMPACTING GREATER MANDEVILLE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply System** that the current disruption in their water supply is due to Jamaica Public Service Company (JPSCo) low voltage issue at the Gutters Pumping Station. Consequently, operations at the Peppers facilities are also being impacted.

As a result, the Greater Mandeville Water Supply System is operating at approximately 50 % and some customers are experiencing low pressure, intermittent or no water supply.

Greater Mandeville Water Supply System service area include: *Pepper, New Castles, Lucky Valley, Ruinett, Phanfiland, Grosmond, Goshen, Bongo Hill, Content, Wilton, Downs, sections of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road* and surrounding areas.

The JPSCo has informed that the power supply issue will be resolved by 6 p.m. today.
