**HIGH TURBIDITY IMPACT WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the shutdown of operations at the **Higgin Town Water Facility** in St. Ann. This has resulted in water supply disruption to the communities served by this facility.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution.
