MECHANICAL PROBLEM FORCES EMERGENCY SHUTDOWN OF ALBION ESTATE WATER FACILITY IN ST. THOMAS

The **National Water Commission** is advising that operations at the Albion Estate Water Facility in St. Thomas have been suspended due to a mechanical problem. As a result, customers in the communities served by this facility will experience water supply disruptions until the corrective work is completed.

The Company is noting that the NWC's maintenance team is currently conducting the necessary assessment and will provide updates on the timeline for restoration of supply to the affected areas.

Areas to be affected: Albion Housing Estate, Sun Valley, Grants Pen, 11 Miles

The NWC will provide trucked water on a scheduled basis to the affected customers in the Interim.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
