NWC resumes operations after two days of disruptions

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers that it has resumed its operations with immediate effect.

Operations restarted on Wednesday evening (May 11, 2022) after an agreement was reached for the employees of the NWC to return to work. The workers had been off the job since early Tuesday morning as part of industrial action led by the five unions representing the staff of the Commission to protest the process of salary review for employees at the company.

The agreement was signed by the Unions, the Ministry of Labour and Social Security (MoLSS), the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MoFPS) and the management of the NWC who had been meeting for two days to resolve the matter and bring an end to the industrial action.

With the employees returning to work, the NWC will resume the provision of water and sewerage services to thousands of Jamaicans who had been negatively impacted by the industrial action.

The NWC, again, apologises to our valued customers for any inconvenience caused as a result of the islandwide disruptions. We continue to crave your patience and understanding as we work to restore the water supply in the shortest possible time.
