HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACTING OPERATIONS AT WHITE RIVER FACILITY IN ST. MARY

The **National Water Commission** is reporting that high turbidity levels are currently impacting pumping operations at the **White River facility** in **St. Mary**. This has caused a disruption in regular water supply to customers served by the facility.

Customers are being assured that once conditions are favorable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas impacted: **Endeavour, Cascade, St. Mary Country Club, Charles Town, Tree Hills, Rock Cottage, Industry Pen**
