HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY
ROCK SPRING, ZION HILL AND ENVIRONS IN ST. MARY AFFECTED

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the shutdown of operations at the **Rock Spring Water Facility** in **St. Mary**. This will result in water supply disruption to communities supplied by the facility.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favorable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas Affected: **Rock Spring, Beecham Hill, Zion Hill, Flint River, sections of Richmond and Essex**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
