**NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY TO MARCUS  
GARVEY AREAS**  
SEAVIEW GARDENS AND ENVIRONS ALSO IMPACTED

The National Water Commission is advising that its teams are now working to restore water supply to the Marcus Garvey Drive and Seaview Gardens areas that have been impacted by on-going interconnection works along the Spanish Town Road belt.

The company is noting that some areas have been successfully connected to the new pipelines but onsite challenges hampered the completion of works to pipelines that supply Seaview Gardens and a section of Marcus Garvey Drive. Notwithstanding, the NWC is noting that good progress is being made with the restoration process for these areas.

Completion Time: **3pm today, June 21, 2022**

Areas to be impacted: **Marcus Garvey Drive, Seaview Gardens and Environs**

Customers are reminded to expect low pressures initially as the system will require several hours for recharge after the shutdown now underway.

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply ahead of the stipulated timelines.
