CAMBRIDGE TREATMENT PLANT OPERATING AT 50 PER CENT CAPACITY

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that operations at the **Cambridge Treatment Plant** in **St James**, have been reduced to 50 per cent capacity due to blocked intake.

As a result, customers in St James and Westmoreland will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Customers are being assured that normality will return to the facility as soon as the issue is resolved.

Areas affected include in **St James** include **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge** and **Cambridge Proper**.

Areas affected in **Westmoreland** include **Ducketts, Greenwich, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain** and **Lambs River**.
