**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACTING WATER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION
TRINITYVILLE WATER FACILITY IN ST. THOMAS AFFECTED**

The **National Water Commission** is reporting that high turbidity levels have forced the suspension of operations at the **Trinityville Water Facility in St. Thomas**. This has caused a disruption in regular water supply to customers served by this system.

Customers are being advised that once conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas impacted: **Somerset, Danvers Pen, Trinityville, Coley and Anglican Lane**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort is being made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
