**NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY TO SPRING VILLAGE AREAS  
IN ST CATHERINE**

The National Water Commission is advising its customers that its teams are now working to restore regular water supply to several St. Catherine areas that have been affected by a disruption at the Spring Village plant. The Company is indicating that normal operations are expected within the next 5-6 hours.

Areas affected: **Bushy Park, Spring Village, Island Farm, Nightingale Grove, Five Acres, Round Wood, High House, Lloyd's Pen, Rock Stone, and Gutters**

Restoration Timeline: **3pm today, August 4, 2022**

Persons are also being reminded to allow for a gradual improvement in pressures as the system recharges.

The NWC apologises to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure them that every effort will be made to restore regular water supply in the shortest possible time.
