**SINGLE PHASE POWER PROBLEM DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY**  
BELMONT, MOUNT OLGLE AND ENVIRONS IN WEST RURAL ST. ANDREW AFFECTED

The **National Water Commission** is reporting that single phase power problem has affected pumping operation at the **King Weston Water Facility in West Rural St. Andrew**. This has resulted in water supply disruption to customers served by the facility.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and full operation will resume as soon as regular power supply is restored at the facility.

Areas impacted: **Belmont, sections of Bucky Plain, Grant Hill, Florence Hill, Lawrence Tavern, Mount Ogle, Matthew Road, Toms River, Cokely and Johnny Ridge**
