HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS STILL IMPACTING WATER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION PEACE RIVER WATER FACILITY IN CLARENDON AFFECTED

Customers are being advised that once conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas impacted: **Peace River, Gloucester, Victoria, Lodge, Thompson Town, Cove Wesleyan Gully, Blackwood and Elgin**
