**FALLEN JPSCo POLE DISRUPT OPERATIONS AT THE
FOREST HILLS DEEPWELL AND RELIFT SYSTEMS**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that a fallen JPSCo pole caused by a motor vehicular accident, has disrupted power supply at the **Forest Hills Deepwell and Relift Systems in St. Andrew**. This has caused water supply disruption to customers in sections of Red Hills and its environs.

The public service provider is currently carrying out the necessary repairs. Regular water supply is estimated to be restored by late tonight into Tuesday morning, upon the restoration of power supply at the facility. Customers are however reminded to expect gradual water supply resumption until the network is fully recharged.

Areas affected: **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Vallery, Sterling Castle, Forest Hills, Perkins Boulevard and Leas Flats**
