MECHANICAL ISSUE IMPACTS WATER SUPPLY TO SPANISH TOWN AREAS

The National Water Commission is advising its customers that the Friendship Water supply in St Catherine has now been shut down as a result of a mechanical issue. This shutdown has resulted in water supply disruptions (low pressures or no water conditions) for the communities supplied by the facility.

Affected areas include: **Fairfield Road, St. John's Road, Homestead, Clayton Heights, Fletcher's Lane, Willowdene, Hopedale, Villa Nova, Old Harbour Road, Sydenham, Cromarty H/S, Leiba Gdns, Ebony Vale H/S, Horizon Pk, McCook's Pen, Hartlands, White Water Meadows H/S**

The NWC is noting that its teams are now carrying out an assessment of the damaged equipment in order to determine the earliest timeline for repairs and a restart of water supply distribution.

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience that this disruption in service may cause.
