SCHEDULED JPSCo POWER OUTAGE TO IMPACT SOME NWC FACILITIES IN CLARENDON

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that scheduled JPSCo power outage will impact operations at the **Mineral Heights, Hayes, Twin Palms and New Bowens Facilities** in **Clarendon**, from **7am to 9am, on Saturday, November 26, 2022**.

Customers served by these systems are being encouraged to store water for use during the disruption period.

Areas to be impacted: **Mineral Heights, Hale Hall, May Pen, Curatoe Hill, Canaan Heights, Trenton Road, Longbridge Avenue, Sunnyside Avenue, Hayes Cornpiece, Savannah, Hayes Cornpiece, Savannah, Twin Palms, Green Bottom, sections of Palmers Cross, New Bowens, Halse Hall, Hunts Pen**

Regular water supply operations will be restarted once the power supply is restored at the facilities.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
