**SINGLE PHASE POWER SUPPLY PROBLEM DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission is reporting that single phase power supply problem has affected pumping operation at the **Mount Pellier Water Facility** in **St. Thomas**. This has resulted in water supply disruption to customers served by the facility.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and full operation will resume as soon as regular power supply is restored at the facility.

Areas impacted: **Newland, Pamphret, Pondsides and Lowden Hill**
