**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACTING WATER SUPPLY**

The **National Water Commission** is reporting that high turbidity levels are currently impacting operations at the **Liberty and Breadnut Hill Water Facilities in St. Ann**. This has caused a disruption in regular water supply to customers served by the facilities.

Customers are being advised that once conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate the re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas impacted: **Liberty, Tanglewood, Roadside, Lewis Banks and Breadnut Hill**
