Turbidity Disrupts Operations at Cambridge & Niagara Facilities In St. James

The National Water Commission is monitoring the inflow of water at its Cambridge and Niagara, Vaughnsfield facilities in St. James, due to high levels of turbidity. Customers served are experiencing a disruption in their regular water supply.

Affected NWC service areas include:

Cambridge Treatment Plant

Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge, Ducketts, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain, Greenwich, Retrieve and Lambs River.

Niagara Treatment Plant

Niagara, Johnson, Elderslie

Full operations will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.
