**HIGH TURBIDITY LEVELS IMPACT LIBERTY WATER FACILITY IN ST. ANN

The National Water Commission is advising that high turbidity levels have forced the shutdown of operations at the **Liberty Water Facility in St. Ann**. This has caused a disruption in regular water supply to customers served by this system.

Customers are being advised that once the conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operations and water supply distribution.

Areas affected: **Liberty, Tanglewood, Roadside and Lewis Banks**

The National Water Commission apologises for any inconvenience caused and seeks to assure its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the shortest possible time.
