The National Water Commission is advising that the operation at the Barnstaple Water Facility in Trelawny is currently suspended due to high turbidity levels. This has disrupted water supply to customers served by the facility.

The company is however stating that once conditions are favourable, the necessary remedial activities will be carried out to facilitate a re-start of operation and water supply distribution.

Affected areas are:

Barnstaple, Westwood, Stewart Town, Jackson Hill, Biddiford, Mahogany Hall
