The National Water Commission is advising that operations at the **Cookhamdene and Tavistock Facilities** in **St. Andrew** will be suspended from **10:00am to 5:00pm tomorrow Tuesday, November 21, 2023**, to facilitate emergency network activities.

Work duration: 10:00am - 5:00pm on Tuesday, November 21, 2023

Customers served by these systems will experience water supply disruption and are being encouraged to store water for use during the period.

Areas to be affected: **Whitford Drive, Temple Meade, Pinkneys Green, Kinsale Avenue, Cookhamdene, Braywick Avenue, Bracknell Avenue, Hyperion Avenue, Farrington Drive, Farrington Heights, Ridgeway, Ridgeway Terrace, Roedeen Close, Riva Ridge, Shortridge Drive and Avenue, Wilmington Drive, Millsborough Ave and Crescent, Plymouth Avenue, Doorly Boulevard, Widcombe Heights**
