**EMERGENCY LEAK REPAIRS DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY TO
SECTIONS OF TRELAWNY**

The National Water Commission is advising that operations at the Queen of Spain 1, 2 and 3 facilities in Trelawny have been temporarily suspended due to major leak repair works. As a result, customers served by facilities are currently experiencing a disruption in their regular water supply.

Areas affected include Wakefield, Deeside, Bunkers Hill, Friendship, Unity, Dromlley, Bounty Hall, Hammersmith, New Cargen, Hampden, Green Park, Bounty Hall Reservoir, Falmouth, Greenwood, Rose Hall, Coral Gardens, Ironshore, Rhyne Park # 1, Terminal

The team is working to complete repairs by midnight today.
