SINGLE PHASE POWER ISSUE AFFECTING WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the Darliston Units at the Roaring River Treatment Plant in Westmoreland, that the current disruption in their regular water supply is due to a single phase power supply issue at the facilities.

Areas to be affected include: Roaring River, Cornwall Mountain, Barneyside, Water Works, Whithorn, Caledonia, Darliston, Cottage, Enfield, Strawberry, Mount Theresa, Galloway, Orange Hill, Cold Spring, Myers Hall, Mount Stewart, Belvedere, Big Woods and surrounding areas.

The power supply provider has been notified and full operations will resume as soon as the issue is resolved.
