## **JPS SINGLE PHASE DISRUPTS OPERATION AT SHETTLEWOOD AND CAMBRIDGE FACILITIES**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by the **Shettlewood** facility in **Hanover** and the **Cambridge** facility in **St James** for the disruption in their water supply due to JPS single phase issue.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and water will be restored as soon as the matter is resolved.

Areas affected include:

### In Hanover

**Chester Castles, Shettlewood, Friendship, Lethe Ramble, Knockalva, Copse, Pearces, Village, Burnt Ground, Mount Peto and Haughton Grove.**

### In St James

**Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood and Cambridge**

### In Westmoreland

**Ducketts, Greenwich, Bethel Town and Argyle Mountain**
