TO SECTIONS OF TRELAWNY AND ST ELIZABETH**

Areas affected in **Trelawny** include **Sherwood, Peidmount, Reserve** and **Coxheath**

Areas affected in **St Elizabeth** include **Union, Raheen, Marlborough, Russell Hill, Phoenix Park, Balaclava, St. Pauls, Roses Valley, Comfort Hall, Content, Free Town, Evergreen, Mount Pleasant** and **Beverley**.
