**LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT WATER
SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, the **Porus Pumping Station** in **Manchester**, will be shut down from **10:00 pm Thursday April 21, 2022** through to **6:00 pm Friday April 22, 2022**, to facilitate leak repairs on the Broadleaf main road.

Every effort will be made to complete the work and restore water supply within the time specified.

Areas to be affected include **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Hanbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, section of Grey Ground, Grove Mount, Three Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Melrose Mews, Dorby Subdivision, Land Settlement** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
