PRODUCTION AT CAMBRIDGE TREATMENT PLANT DECLINES BY 70%

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that there is a 70% decline in production at the **Cambridge Treatment Plant** in **St. James**, due to electro-mechanical challenges. As a result, customers in sections of **St. James** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility will experience either low or have no water.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and resume full operation by **Saturday, June 11, 2022**.

Areas affected include

In St James

Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood and Cambridge.

In Westmoreland

Ducketts, Greenwich, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain and Lambs River.
