HIGH TURBIDITY AFFECTS OPERATION AT BULSTRODE TREATMENT PLANT, WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that operation at the **Bulstrode Treatment plant** in **Westmoreland**, has been reduced to 50% due to high levels of turbidity. The NWC is assuring customers that normal operation will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.

The areas affected include **Grange Hill, Burnt Savannah, Toll-Gate, Alma, Paul Island, Fullersfield, Little London, Glasgow, Herring Piece, Broughton** and **New Hope**.
