JPS SINGLE PHASE ISSUE AFFECTING OPERATION AT CAMBRIDGE TREATMENT PLANT, ST JAMES

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers in sections of St James and Westmoreland, who are served by Cambridge Treatment Plant for the disruption in their water supply due to JPS single phase at the facility.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and customers are being assured that normal operation will resume as soon as the issue is resolved.

Areas affected include in **St James** include **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge** and **Cambridge Proper**.

Areas affected in **Westmoreland** include **Ducketts, Greenwich, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain** and **Lambs River**.
